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Diseases Of The Kidneys Ureters

Sometimes the ureters can become blocked or injured. This can block the flow of urine to the bladder. If urine stands still or backs up the ureter, you may get a urinary tract infections. Doctors diagnose problems with the ureters using different tests. These include urine tests, x-rays, and examination of the ureter with a scope called a cystoscope.

If symptoms do occur, it is usually in the case of complete duplicated ureters. Duplicated ureters can occur with other abnormalities of the urinary system. One of the more common is ureterocele. With this condition, the end of the ureter does not develop properly, and urine flow is obstructed.

The kidneys may be in the wrong position. One or both kidneys may have fluid-filled cysts (polycystic kidney disease or multicystic kidney disease).

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Anomalies of the ureters A blockage may occur in the area where the kidney attaches to the ureter (ureteropelvic junction obstruction).
