Reporting Verbs . Said, told and asked are the most common verbs used in indirect speech.. We use asked to report questions:-. For example: I asked Lynne

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what time the lesson started.. We use told with an object.. For example: Lynne told me she felt tired.!Note - Here me is the object.. We usually use said without an object.. For example: Lynne said she was going to teach online.
